1. Next match Oct. 5, 2013. Frist relay on the line at 10 Am.
2. The Oct. match will be a Foreign Service rifle match. Only those shooters competing with a service rifle of non U.S. origin will be eligible for prizes to be awarded after the match. All others will compete for score or to make up a league match.
3. We will shoot a sniper match after the FSR match for those that are interested. There will be two divisions. **Military Sniper Rifle** and **Any Sight Rifle**. A scoped military type rifle will compete in **MSR** division and any other rifle will compete in **ASR** division. There will be no classification system used. The course of fire will be 20 shots slow fire in two strings of 10 shots each at the 300 and 600 yd. reduced targets. Sighting shots will be allowed and will be taken during the 3 minute prep period. A 3 minute prep period will precede each 10 shot string. We will shoot as two man teams with one shooter acting as a spotter and then as the shooter. Time limit for the individual strings will be 10 minutes. The spotter is allowed to coach the shooter. Shooting can be done from sand bags or using the sling but not both at the same time.
4. Shooting the FSR match is not required to enter the sniper match. All proceeds after expenses will be donated to the John Larose family. Entry fee for the sniper match will be \$5.00 donations will be accepted.
5. Prizes will be awarded to the best scoring team in each division after the completion of shooting.
