3. Due to the high percentage of unclassified shooters (64%), awards were not made in NRA classifications.
4. All Grand Aggregates accumulated with at least 120 shots were reported for classification.
5. I am thinking about replacing the FSR match with a carbine classifier match for 2009. This will be fired per Army Field Manual FM-23-7 dated 23 Apr 1944. All firing at 1000" (25yds.) , 5 positions, 10 shot strings, 60 sec . per string. 3 minute prep before first string with unlimited sighting shots. Reentries allowed only the last score will be used for classification. If time permits also throw in a one minute Rattle Battle. More on this as the season progresses
